Student and Family Privacy Rights

BP 5022

The Board of Trustees believes that personal information concerning District students and their families should be kept private in accordance with law.

Collection of Personal Information for Marketing Purposes

The Board prohibits District staff from administering or distributing to students survey instruments that are designed for the purpose of collecting personal information for marketing or for selling that information.

California Healthy Kids Survey

The Board's policy is to conduct the California Healthy Kids Survey every two years on a passive consent basis pursuant to Education Code section 51938. Education Code 51513 (i.e. positive permission) will still govern the need for prior written consent for any other surveys about pupil's personal beliefs or practices in sex, family life, morality, and religion, or any questions about the pupil's parents' or guardians' beliefs and practices in sex, family life, morality, and religion.

Student and Family Privacy Rights

AR 5022

Definition

Personal information means individually identifiable information including a student's or parent/guardian's first and last name, a home or other physical address (including street name and the name of the city or town), a telephone number, or a social security identification number. (20 USC 1232h)

The District may administer to students in grades 9-12, the California Healthy Kids Survey to measure student health risks and behaviors as long as parents/guardians are provided written notice and given an opportunity to request that their child not participate. [Education Code 51938]

Parent/Guardian Access to Survey

Upon request, parents/guardians may inspect the California Healthy Kids Survey within a reasonable period of time of receiving the notification.
