

## Student and Family Privacy Rights

5022

The Board believes that personal information concerning district students and their families should be kept private in accordance with law.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish safeguards to protect the student and the student's family from invasion of privacy.

The Superintendent or designee shall consult with parents/guardians regarding the development and revision of this policy and establish regulations for Board approval governing the following: [20 U.S.C. § 1232h.]

1. administration of surveys and physical exams/screenings
2. right of parents to inspect instructional materials, and
3. collection of personal information for marketing purposes.
